

*****PLEASE READ*****

Similar to past seasons, we are attempting to offset more costs for the ballpark. One of the large costs that we incur is payment of concession workers. While we still plan to have a few full time workers in the concession stand, we want to be more fiscally responsible. This is where **YOU** can help. By having parents/grandparents work in the stand just **one** night during the season, we are estimating we can save the ballpark approximately \$2,500.00-\$3,000.00 annually. These funds go back into **YOUR** park!

We have listed the game nights for each league below. Please note which night of the week your child isn't playing so that you can help. We do NOT want you to miss your child's game. A regularly scheduled worker will be in the concession stand for instructions and to assist you through your shift. If you have a schedule conflict on the night you are to work, we ask that you find a replacement or trade your date with another parent. You can certainly sign up for more than one night, as well. If you skip your evening, we will be keeping track of this and you will be required to pay prior to sign-up the next season.

If you sign up for one night to work the concession stand, your entry fee will remain the same. Your child will still have the opportunity to play for **FREE** by selling raffle tickets. This has not changed. If you elect to NOT work in the concession stand, there will be a \$30 increase to your fees to offset our costs for employing someone to work for you.

In an effort to continue to upgrade your ballpark, we are asking for your consideration and assistance without much inconvenience. There will be a concession stand calendar at our Registration Day on Saturday, February 21st, 2026 from 9am to Noon. You can sign up for your one evening to work on that date. If you register your player late, please contact Amy Post (419.302.8932) to coordinate being added to the concession calendar. If you do not contact her, she will reach out to you.
